Biosafety Plan for Comets Stadium

Maximum Capacity - 300 people. (4sqm rule)

Your safety and wellbeing are our highest priority.

This plan is underpinned by Federal and State Government Coronavirus (Covid-19) guidelines and is created to ensure the CSBA reduces person-to-person transmission of Covid-19.

Masks: Masks are **recommended** for everyone in Comets Stadium. Exemptions are in place for players, referees, coaches and CSBA staff who are actively involved in a game. Masks are encouraged but optional for people under the age of 12. Masks can be purchased for \$1 at the entrance (No change can be given).

Service NSW QR code: EVERYONE (including players who also must sign into the scoresheet) must sign into Comets Stadium using the Service NSW QR code provided. You will find these at multiple points at the entrance. All visitors must show the CSBA bio safety officer proof of signing on upon entry. Accompanying minors must be added as a 'dependent' on the Service NSW app.

Spectators: CSBA are currently permitting 1 SPECTATOR PER PLAYER. The following applies:

- Spectators are discouraged from attending.
- Spectators must present to the Bio Safety officer with the accompanying player and sign
 in using the Service NSW QR code. No spectators will be permitted who are not in the
 presence of a player.
- Spectators must always wear a mask inside the venues.
- Spectators must keep a social distance of 1.5 meters from all people who are not household contacts.
- Spectators and players are to depart the venue with 2 minutes of the game finishing. Please help us to get everyone out of the venues so the next group of people can play.

Before the activity:

- Everyone is to 'sign in' using the Service NSW QR code supplied and show proof of sign on to the CSBA Bio Safety officer before entering the stadium.
- Players to also sign the scoresheet upon entry.
- Everyone to sanitise hands upon entry with sanitizer provided.
- All basketballs are to be sanitised upon entry with antibacterial wipes provided.
- Uniform sharing is not permitted.
- CSBA reserves the right to check participants' body temperatures before entering the stadium. Anyone displaying an elevated body temperature will not be permitted to enter the stadium.
- Please keep a social distance of more than 1.5 meters with other people when not playing.

• All players must bring enough water for the whole session. Water fountain may not be available.

During the Activity:

- Game ball to be sanitized before the game and during time outs.
- Please always maintain a social distance of 1.5 meters when you are not playing basketball.
- Hi 5s and hand shaking are not permitted.
- Team benches are for participants only.
- Every time a player touches your mouth guard you are required to sanitise your hands.
- Spectators in Comets Stadium are required to spectate all activities on court 1 and 2 from the Court 1 main grandstand on court 1. No standing near court 2 to spectate. Spectators in other venues will spectate in the designated spectator areas.
- In the event of an injury or if you are feeling unwell, please talk to a staff member or coach immediately.

After the Activity:

- Teams to wipe down benches after each game with wipes provided.
- Participants to collect belongings and leave within 2 minutes of your game finishing. Coaches are to hold post game meetings outside the venue.
- Continue to maintain a social distance of at least 1.5 meters and depart the area in a timely manner.

Symptoms: If you are experiencing fever, sore/scratchy throat, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell or any other flu like symptoms please do not come to any CSBA run program. The NSW government recommend that you self-isolate and get a Covid-19 test immediately.

Self-Isolate: The NSW government require certain people to self-isolate. If you have visited any of these venues or areas at the times indicated, please do not visit Comets Stadium: https://bit.ly/35noonZ

Casual Shooting: CSBA are not currently offering any casual shooting opportunities.

If at any time the maximum number of people exceeds 300, we will have to ask everyone to depart the venue immediately and may resume the activity without spectators.

This plan may be updated accordingly as more information becomes available.
